Membershyp Meetings

The Nashville Catholic Business Women's League (NCBWL) is a non-profit and the Diocese of Nashville's oldest business organization. Since its founding more than 70 years ago, the NCBWL has donated approximately \$400,000 toward scholarships for young women.

When the League first began, it was a small group of Catholic working women, primarily teachers and nurses who wanted to get together to share their faith and support each other in their professional lives. They could only meet at night due to their work schedules, and so the NCBWL was formed.

Today the NCBWL embraces all Catholic women: working professionals, retirees and homemakers. *Our faith is the fabric that weaves us together and guides us — prayer is a part of each meeting.*

Our meetings are held on the third Wednesday of each month from 5:00 to 7:30 PM (usually at a centrally located venue in Nashville). The first hour is for networking and fellowship, followed by a dinner, spiritual reflection, and a featured speaker. Spiritual events are held at least twice a year. Pearls of Wisdom, our annual fundraiser benefiting the Aurelia Varallo Mariani Memorial Scholarship, is held in September.

NCBWL annual dues are \$55. Dinner meetings are typically \$25.
